Revised Masking Policy

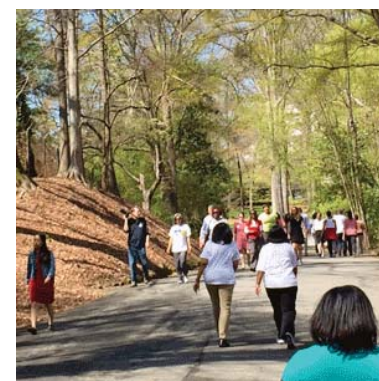
Emory Pride Employee Network Mixer
